Dominica Siu Documentary Scholarship (蕭景路紀錄片獎學金)

To commemorate Ms. Dominica Siu's contribution to the media industry and society at large, the alumni of The Chinese University of Hong Kong and the community have kindly pledged to donate scholarships annually to outstanding students of the School of Journalism and Communication. Starting from the academic year 2020/21, the regulations governing the award of the Scholarship are as below:

- 1. The scholarship will be known as "Dominica Siu Documentary Scholarship" and in Chinese 蕭景路紀錄片獎學金.
- 2. There will be one to two award(s) annually for the undergraduate student(s) of the School of Journalism and Communication. The amount of each award will be HK\$10,000 or HK\$20,000.
- 3. To be eligible, the students must:
 - be undergraduate students of the School of Journalism and Communication; and
 - have demonstrated great potential in documentary making by submitting a documentary done in the previous 12 months, i.e. from October 2019 to September 2020. The work has to be completely original. It can be an individual or a group production in which the candidates serve as director or reporter.
- 4. If there is/are no candidate(s) of sufficient merit, no award(s) will be made.
- 5. Each year, the School of Journalism and Communication will collect all the applications and the Selection Committee will select suitable candidates for the scholarship. The Selection Committee will be formed by two faculty members of the School of Journalism and Communication and one external member from the media industry.

- 1. There will be one to four award(s) annually for undergraduate student(s) of the School of Journalism and Communication.
- 2. The amount of each award will be from HK\$5,000 to \$20,000.
- 3. The scheme is to subsidise students' documentary production, attendance at film festivals or participation in production-related study trips.
- 4. To be eligible, the students must:
 - be undergraduate students of the School of Journalism and Communication and the person-in-charge (e.g. Director or Reporter) of the production proposal;
 - submit a proposal which provides all major details (e.g. personal information of the participants, title, estimated length, logline and synopsis of the proposed film, proposed budget, etc) of a documentary production; OR
 - submit relevant proofs (e.g. acceptance letters from film festivals) and outline planned learning activities in writing
- 5. If there is/are no candidate(s) of sufficient merit, no award(s) will be made.
- 6. Each year, the School of Journalism and Communication will collect all the applications and the Selection Committee will select suitable awardees for the scheme. The Selection Committee will be formed by two faculty members of the School of Journalism and Communication and one external member from the media industry.
