	SEEM2430, SOCI2004, SPED2600, STAT2001 and 2006, STAT2101 and 2102 are exempted from taking PSYC2010, and they are required to take another PSYC course listed under 3(b) Elective Courses (2000 or above level) to compensate for the units.
[b]	Students are required to take PSYC3430. Journalism and Communication and Psychology Double Major Programme students who have taken ENGE3610 or LING3202 will be exempted from taking PSYC3430, and they are required to take another PSYC course listed under 3(b) Elective Courses (2000 or above level) to compensate for the units.
[c]	Students who take 12 units from 3(a) Elective Courses are required to take at least 12 units from 3(b) Elective Courses.
[d]	Students who take 15 units from 3(a) Elective Courses are required to take at least 9 units from 3(b) Elective Courses.
